


"Did you Who Dat in your home?

"I did dat Who Dat in the Quarter. I did dat by dat Muddy Water."






"I did dat Who Dat in Jackson Square. I did dat Who Dat everywhere."

I did dat Who Dat on a plane.


I did dat Who Dat on a train."
